Colorado's first Cowgirl Adventure kicks off on May 7<sup>th</sup> on the Western slope of the Rocky Mountains. This trip marks the first of its kind adventure series in the majestic Colorado Rockies.

Riders on the Craig trip will spend four days in a remote location set on 17,000 acres of sagebrush country and rolling hills. Expect to rope, ride and herd. Christy says, "Plan on getting your hands dirty and your boots muddy!" This true working horse ranch is a fabulous place to hone your riding and ranching skills, as you learn all that's required in the care of ranch horses.

Riders choosing the Browns Park adventure will live the dream of riding in a remote location in a lush mountain valley of northern Colorado. Over 75,000 acres of owned and leased land parallels the Sand Wash Basin Wild Mustang Preserve. Riders have the opportunity to search for and view the wild mustang herd up close and personal in this valley that was once a gathering place for outlaws, ranchers and trappers.

For a mellower pace, join the Williams Fork adventure. This stunning location near Steamboat Springs is nestled in an aspen grove and surrounded by the Flat Top Wilderness Range. In addition to trail riding, indulge in yoga or massage for a lovely, relaxing adventure. Sheila says, "Each trip has a unique flavor, and is really designed to make your horseback dreams a reality."
